Purpose of Allocation: The purpose of ESSER III is to:

- Address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students by combating learning losses, supporting social-emotional needs and ensuring a safe return to the school environment for students.
- Mitigate the effects of the COVID -19 pandemic by taking additional steps for continued in-person instruction and addressing unfinished teaching and learning.
- Please note: At least 20% of this allocation of ESSER III funding must be allocated to address student's learning loss.
