NSCAS State Wide Assessment is given each spring. All students in third through sixth grade complete the Nebraska Student Centered Assessment System Test. It is important that your child be present during these assessments in order to get an accurate picture of his/her level of mastery in relation to the state standards. NSCAS Tests begin Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup> for students in 3<sup>rd</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> grade. The following suggestions will help you support your child during the testing period:

- On the evenings prior to the test, relax and have an enjoyable evening before going to bed.
- Get a good night's sleep.
- Set the alarm clock to avoid having to rush in the morning.
- Eat a healthy breakfast.
- Arrive at school on time.






