# Principal's Update

Welcome Back, Bennet Families!

What a great first week back at Bennet Elementary. It's been so good to have our students back in the building, filling the hallways and classrooms with energy and life. From our youngest learners to our oldest leaders, everyone jumped right in and started the year strong.

Routines are starting to click, classrooms are busy with learning, and it's clear students are already building connections with their teachers and classmates. The excitement for the year ahead is visible, and we're ready to keep the momentum going.

Please read below on important updates and reminders to help us establish strong routines and procedures for the start of the year.

# **Dismissal Changes**

Coordinating the dismissal plans for 350 students each day is extremely challenging and time consuming for the office staff. If you have a change request, we ask that these are communicated to the office by 2:00 each day. Ideally, the transportation plan is consistent day to day. We understand that some days a change is needed. However, receiving these requests within an hour of dismissal is a challenge for ensuring timely communication to staff to ensure these students get to where they need to go. Please assist in helping make this process smooth and effective.

We want to remind all families about the law regarding school buses and student safety. When a school bus stops and extends its red stop sign arm, all vehicles in both directions must come to a complete stop, even if the bus is on a highway or rural road with higher speed limits (such as Highway 43).

This applies to both lanes of traffic, whether you are behind the bus or approaching from the opposite direction. The only exception is if there is a physical median or barrier separating the lanes.

Failing to stop is not only illegal but extremely dangerous for children getting on or off the bus. Please help us keep our students safe by following this law every time you encounter a stopped school bus.

# Lost and Found

The Bennet Elementary Lost and Found is located in the front entry vestibule on the south side. We encourage parents and students to look through the lost and found throughout the year to locate any missing items.

#### **Arrival Procedures**

Students in the Rec Program may be dropped off starting at 7:00. All other students should arrive no earlier than 7:50 unless they are riding the bus or attending the Rec Program. The front doors will open at 7:50, and staff will begin monitoring the drop-off line at that time. Students dropped off before 7:50 will be unsupervised and the doors will be locked. Breakfast will be served from 7:50 to 8:20 daily. During arrival, students will gather in the Bennet Commons until 8:20 and then be escorted to classrooms. The school day starts at 8:20, and the tardy bell rings at 8:25.

If you are dropping a student off to ride the morning bus shuttles to PHS and have elementary students with them, we cannot provide supervision for students prior to 7:30. Please have students wait in the car until this time as the buses do not arrive until 7:30.

# **Parent Drop Off and Pickup Procedures**

A few reminders that I would like to share to help everyone get in and out quickly:

- Please have students enter and exit your vehicle on the passenger side of your vehicle. The drop off lane is extremely effective and the safety of your student is our top priority. By doing this, we can ensure that students are not in zones of traffic and are not in harm's way.
- If you are using the parent drop/pick up lanes, please stay in your vehicles. If you would like to park and walk up, please utilize the parking spaces in the interior of the parent pickup/dropoff lane.
- In the afternoon **only**, Kindergarten parents may utilize the bus drop off lane for pickup for Kindergarten students and older siblings. Grades 1-5 will continue to use the primary pickup/dropoff lane. Teachers have now been assigned zones to help aid in the location of your students to help you get in and out guickly.

# Strategies for Helping with Separation Fears

- 1) Create a fun drop off routine (Secret handshake or verbal routines)
- 2) Read relatable books (The Kissing Hand, Invisible String, and many other wonderful options! You can borrow a copy from the school counselor if needed)
- 3) Show your excited for school
- 4) Validate your student's feelings (Let them know it is okay to feel their feelings and provide strategies to help them through it. Deep breathing, counting to 10, positive affirmations, etc.)

It is normal to see these separation fears anytime there is change, such as the start of the new school year. Please know your student may take some time to adapt to the changes, but they are loved and cared for at school. Together, we will make this a great year!

Are you looking for a way to become more involved? Meet new parents? Help out our amazing teachers? Then we have an awesome opportunity for you!

Bennet Boosters is excited to announce the "Parent Ambassador Program" for the 2025-2026 school year. We are looking for 1-2 Parent Ambassadors for each classroom.

## What are the primary duties as a parent ambassador?

- 1. Plan classroom holiday parties (Halloween, Christmas and Valentine's Day)
  - Ambassadors will plan 2-3 age-appropriate activities (example: 1 game, 1 craft, 1 snack)
  - Ambassadors will coordinate 2-3 parent volunteers to attend the party and assist with activity and handing out snacks.
  - Ambassadors will request donations from classroom parents via Signup Genius for snack. Can also request donations for craft/game if needed.
  - Goal is for the classroom teacher to focus on enjoying the day with the students and the Ambassadors (with assigned parent volunteers) to coordinate and manage the party.

#### 3. Other Duties

 Ambassador will work with the classroom teacher to determine any extra needs there may be for that year. This may vary teacher to teacher and grade level to grade level.

- Ambassador will use Signup Genius to make donation requests for snacks, holiday craft supplies, etc.

# Standard Response Protocol

Bennet Elementary's adoption of the Standard Response Protocol (SRP) provides a standardized approach to managing various events, both threatening and non-threatening, that may happen in or around our school.

These protocols provide actions for the following situations:

- Lockout (danger is outside the school)
- Lockdown (danger is inside the school)
- Evacuate (leave the school building, such as a fire)
- Shelter (tornado or severe weather)
- Hold (stay in classrooms due to a non-threatening event outside the classroom)
